Glen Baldrige responds to a few questions asked by a local reporter.

***What is a G-Pak?*** The G-Pak is a completely Durable, Reusable, Recyclable, Advanced Packing, Shipping and Storage Container

System. The G-Pak is made of recycled fluted and corrugated polypropylene sheets and constructed with the most modern techniques of extrusion that provide countless advantages, including being light weight, resistant to chemical and atmospheric agents, fire resistant, customizable, reusable, and you have the ability to recycle the entire G-Pak product once it’s life cycle is complete.

***What can I use the G-Pak for?*** The application of the G-PAK is practically endless. One of its many highlights is its flexibility allowing for it to be used to store a wide variety of products in a multitude of sectors, including the logistic, food, automotive, pharmaceutical, health care, household, warehouse, and a many other industries.

***Why the G-Pak?*** For years the DOD has been utilizing shipping and storage boxes that are far from environmentally friendly and cost effective. The majority of shipping storage boxes that are used throughout military installations in the continental United States and overseas are primarily composed of corrugated cardboard. The disadvantages of these products outweigh their advantages. They simply do not hold up to inclement weather or damp environments, once they are saturated with dust and particles they cannot be reused due to environmental hazards, says workers at Agricultural Cleaning Facility’s and they are not fire resistant. The G-Pak covers all of these critical challenges and is a full spectrum tough and sturdy, low cost, reusable substitute.
